## ✓ STAYING POWER

We prepare new teachers for careers in DC schools. **After 5 years, 82% of our Fellows are still in the classroom - well over the national average of 50%.**

## ✓ DIVERSITY

Of the teachers we prepare, **40% are people of color**, which is **more than twice the national average** for the US teaching workforce.

## ✓ AGENCY

**More than 80% take ownership for student learning**, instead of attributing students' ability to succeed primarily to external factors like parent engagement or income level.

## ✓ QUALITY

CLASS (TM) is a nationally validated teacher observation tool that predicts positive academic and social outcomes for students. Compared to a UVA study of national average scores, recent Inspired Teaching Fellows' scores show that:

- **81% are on par or above in Instructional Support**
- **71% are on par or above in Classroom Organization**
- **92% are on par or above in Emotional Support**

## ✓ LEADERSHIP

82% of our lead teachers report that our **Fellows are ready to improve school community and culture**. 76% confirm our Fellows are ready to **collaborate with colleagues on curriculum, lesson planning, data analysis, and more**
